- 2) This hindered Medusa's ability to charge batteries and make water
- 3) Medusa Requested that Azure stop racing and deliver clean fuel mid ocean
- 4) Azure stopped racing and delivered 5.5 gallons of fuel to Medusa mid ocean.
- 5) Medusa made about 30 gallons of water and charged batteries enough to make Honolulu
